The Holocaust and its analogy to other genocides is a recurring topic in both academic and educational discussion. The current research on mass violence raises imminent questions about the place of the Holocaust in the history of genocide.

The main focus of the Conference is not so much the relation of the Holocaust and other genocides in itself as the fact that this relation, ever since Raphael Lemkin coined the term genocide in 1944 and the United Nations adopted the Genocide Convention on December 9, 1948, is a pivotal part of the international discourse.
